<b>Teaching Process</b>	Name, date & title with TEAMS Learning Center on a half-sheet of cardstock, paint baby's hand and make a print onto the paper as a gift for family members.	Introduce the gigantic soft blocks for the babies to explore and climb on. Place in ways to challenge crawlers and lay littles on top for them to feel the slick surface.	Gather plastic food in a basket for babies to find & explore. Let each baby have their own basket of food, name each food as they discover it. Sign or say in Spanish if you can.	Provide a bin of simple to connect bunny builders in the baby's environment to explore & model how to put the pieces together to connect them to create their own structure.	Get baby engaged in front of the mirror and put a small dot of washable paint on their nose and show them how to wipe it off or explain how you are.
<b>Materials Needed</b>	Cardstock, paint bottle, washcloth for cleaning up.	Gigantic vinyl blocks and space to set them up.	Two baskets, plastic easy to clean play foods.	Bunny builder manipulatives in a basket	Washable paint, wipes and warm washcloths.
<b>Info &amp; Adaptations</b>	Leave space on page for parents to write a note if they are giving it away.	Wipe them down completely after each session to keep clean.	Wash all play food with warm soapy water after each use & sanitize too.	Will likely get dumped out often, make a game of putting them back.	Ask permission to wipe their faces before you do it for them to see.

	HANDWASHING SONGS  Sing the handwashing songs while you wash hands in the sink.	BIG KID STORYTIME  Visit the big kid classroom and read a story in a small group spontaneously.	CRAWLING OVER  Encourage crawlers to crawl over the blocks and the littles to watch them.	FREE ART DRAWING  Tape a paper to the top of the table and supply a washable marker to baby.	WHISKING UP SUDS  Add liquid soap to warm water and use a whisk to create suds.
